


Saturday, October 20, 7:30 pm - The Jamie Notarthomas Trio

Listening to Little Toby Walker is like traveling from here to blues country and everywhere in between. Toby's unique fingering style and his passion for the blues, combined with old-fashioned story telling, make you believe you are sitting in the room with him at the knee of legends like Etta Baker, Eugene Powell, James "Son" Thomas, R. L. Burnside, and others. His awards include the International Blues Challenge Award, he has played showcase performances at many of the national blues shows, and he has shared the bill with folks like Richie Havens, Bo Diddley, Savoy Brown, Sonny Landreth, and more.
